It reveals that the literacy and numeracy skills of 16 to 24-year-olds are among the lowest in the developed world, and in general, are no better than those of their grandparents. Overall, in England, young people came 22nd for literacy and 21st for numeracy out of 24 countries." Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) "The report, by the OECD warns that the UK needs to take significant action to boost the basic skills of the nation's young people. The 460-page study is based on the first-ever survey of the literacy, numeracy and problem-solving at work skills of 16 to 65-year-olds in 24 countries, with almost 9,000 people taking part in England and Northern Ireland to make up the UK results. The findings showed that England and Northern Ireland have some of the highest proportions of adults scoring no higher than Level 1 in literacy and numeracy - the lowest level on the OECD's scale.
